### **PART - A :**

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards Quality enhancement and the outcome achieved by the end of the year -

### **PLAN OF ACTION : 2005-06 :**

1. IQAC, Goreswar College proposes to apply to UGC for Grant to improve the infrastructure facilities of Goreswar College, which includes - Girls Hostel, Auditorium and development of playground etc.
2. To have a better academic environment and transparency in Education IQAC of Goreswar College plans to form a Parent-Teacher Association and sit twice a year first on January and Second in the month of August.
3. IQAC has plans to help the poor meritorious students financially by giving them free admission, free text book etc. in the college.
4. To improve the conversational skill in English IQAC propose to start a regular spoken. English Course in Goreswar College through the Department of English.

5. IQAC proposes to start special tutorial classes for degree students from 2005 during the summer vacation. The respective faculty members will take the responsibilities on various subjects without any remuneration.
6. To increase the enrolment in major courses the faculty members are suggested and encouraged by IQAC to take society related programmes like Survey Programmes, subject oriented social programmes, Awareness campaign etc. to make their subject lively and interesting.
7. IQAC has plan to introduce vocational certificate course on Sericulture, Tailoring, Knitting & Cutting etc. to give a professional access to the poor and needy students.
8. As a part of internal examination reforms IQAC plans to hold oral examination in different subject for 20 marks to evaluate the academic interest and progress of the student in major subject.
9. To have a better Library facility IQAC proposes to offer Reprographic facility at the central Library.
10. IQAC of Goreswar College plans to encouraged Faculty members to take up Research activities, Research Project and participation in Seminar and workshop.
11. IQAC has plan to make arrangement to apply to UGC for organising National seminar under the auspices of different departments.
12. IQAC proposes to organise student centred popular talks on subjects of course oriented topic.

13. IQAC proposes to apply to the UGC for organising remedial classes with UGC grants which is not yet received.
14. IQAC proposes to offer training courses of computer application to the Faculty members.

**Outcome achieved by the end of the year :**

- 1.A). In the infrastructure facility Goreswar College has achieved a grant of Rs. 15,00,000.00 (Rupees fifteen lakhs) only for construction of Girls' Hostel from UGC, North Eastern Regional Office. The first instalment of Rs. 7,50,000.00 (Rupees seven lakhs fifty thousand) only is received by the college authority vide letter no. F-16-46/2004-05/W.H./NERO/2636 dated 20.03.06.
- B). The Sports and Youth Affairs Ministry, New Delhi has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 2,50,000.00 (Rupees two lakh fifty thousand) only for construction of a Multi Gymnastics Hall for Physical Education vide letter no. F 38-44/2004/SP-1 dated 31.03.2005. Accordingly the Gymnastics Hall is constructed in the College Campus.
2. On 04.01.05 a Parent-Teacher Association is formed by the Principal of Goreswar College. The Co-ordinator of IQAC being the Convenor of the Association sit with the Parents of the locality twice a year to discuss the core issues related with the Teaching- Learning Processes.
3. In the Session 2005-06 Goreswar College has helped 4 meritorious students belongs to below poverty line giving them free admission in the degree course as proposed by the IQAC.

4. The proposed special tutorial classes for the degree students are started during the summer vacation by the Faculty members of respective departments without remuneration.
5. To make major courses more attractive and lively the departments are initiating various society related programmes like survey programmes Awareness Campaign and spot sight verification etc. from this session in a regular and compulsory basis.
6. As internal Examination reforms proposed by the IQAC the Departments hold oral examination in different subject for 20 marks as a part of evaluation of academic progress of the major students.
7. As proposed and Guidelines of UGC under Faculty Improvement Programme, the Faculty members are engaging themselves in Active Research Work (Ph.D.). As many as 8 Teachers are engaged in Ph.D. work. Apart from this they are regularly participating in seminars and workshops to keep themselves upto date with the recent trend and development in their respective discipline. One MRP is already sanctioned to one Faculty member.
8. During the period of annual college week student centered popular talks on subjects of course related topic is organised to give the student community a better habit to subject related course reading.
9. Under the auspices of Seminar Cell, Goreswar College has applied to UGC for organizing national Seminar in the topic vocationalisation of Higher Education - Problems & Prospects. But UGC has informed the College to modify the topic and again it will be applied in the next session.

10. As a part of computer training many faculty members of the college has attended training courses in computer application. Due to some constraint the college is not able to offer a full time computer course to the Faculty members.

The IQAC of Goreswar College has identified 14 segments in the college to put them into the arena of plan of action in 2005-06. Out of these 14 segments the college has fulfilled 10 segments fully and partially. The remaining 4 segments will be fulfilled in the next session in priority basis.

**i). Progress Report of Academic Cell :**

More or less each and every academic function of Goreswar College is guided by Academic Cell. The members of the Academic cell use to have atleast one sitting in a week. The cell use to evaluate the on going routine, the internal progress of the various Departments, the constructive revision of the syllabus, supervision of the tutorial classes.

Apart from this, the Academic cell regularly published the Academic calendar of the college every year. The Academic cell is also empowered to give constructive suggestions to the various Departments for the positive upliftment of the quality Education of the student community of the college. It is also responsible to advice the various Deptts. in the matter of proper maintenance of the departmental activities along with the Academic matter.

**ii). Progress Report of Extension Education Cell :**

Under the guidance of Extension Education Cell of Goreswar College various steps has been taken to implement various projects in different sectors. To implement these programmes the concern cell use to collects its fund from the college authority and from the voluntary contributions from the teaching and office staff of Goreswar College.

The cell initiated the following programme -

**\* Camp at Goreswar High Madrassa School :**

On 12.09.05, a renovation programme was held under the guidance of Extension Education Cell of Goreswar College. The programme was projected in

Goreswar High Madrassa, which is situated in a very nearby area of Goreswar. The programme was started in the presence of the principal of Goreswar College and the Head Master of Goreswar High Madrassa School.

During the programme certain plans were implemented. They are -

- a) The Extension Education Cell had finance the concern school to construct the main entrance road of the school.
- b) The cell had also sponsored the school to renovate the boundary fencing of the school.
- c) The same cell of Goreswar College had also executed a plan of tree plantation. Under this programme lots of valuable trees were planted in the boundaries of the school.

**iii). Progress Report of Student Welfare Cell :**

The student Welfare Cell of Goreswar College has taken certain innovative projects to develop the welfare programmes of the student community of the college. To achieve the developmental goals in the part of the students, the taken steps are as follows :

The programme which has been executed under the supervision of the student welfare cell was related with health concerning matter. Under this programme a seminar was organized by the student welfare cell on 03.09.05 in collaboration with seminar cell of Goreswar College. The subject of the seminar was "Deficiency of iron among the girl students" on 03.09.05.



The seminar was addressed by Dr. S.K. Das the Health Officer of Goreswar Primary Health Centre (P.H.C.). The seminar has its relevance because now-a-days iron deficiency among girls has become a very much prominent Health problem among the females. During the discussion the resource person tried to highlight the various problems and the symptoms of the problems. It was also tried to make the students know that how it is possible to prevent the iron deficiency problem.

**iv). Progress Report of General Infrastructure Cell :**

To maintain the overall looking of Infrastructural facility of course, Goreswar college has a General Infrastructural cell which is primarily responsible for the maintenance and development of infrastructural facility. In the continuous process the cell has convinced the college authority and applied for the grants for permanent building for Girls' Hostel, College Auditorium and also applied for many other construction. Through the infrastructure cell the college has received Rs. 20,000.00 (Rupees twenty lakhs) only from the Bodoland Territorial Council, which has developed the infrastructural strength of the institution.

**v). Progress Report of Statistical Cell :**

The statistical cell of Goreswar College use to restore all kinds of statistical data concerning, the matters of examination, total student strength, strength of male and female students etc. The cell is responsible for the proper preservation of the data concerning all matters. Along with this the cell has to provide these data to all Departments and administrative staff when necessary.

**vi). Progress Report of Career Counselling Cell :**

Career Counselling Cell of Goreswar College use to do certain functions which can pave the way for the students to choose proper career options for them. The programmes organised under the career counselling cell is as follows :

**One day workshop on : 21/11//05**

A one day programme was organised under the supervision of career counselling cell of Goreswar College. The main objective of the cell is to make the students know about availability of multiple career choices in present time.

In the workshop a few step was highlighted to inspire the students to take modern career options like, information technology, fashion technology and Hotel management etc.

Two leading career counsellors were invited to lead the programme. The experts were Dr. Rashmi Sarmah and Jayanta Madhav.

**vii). Progress Report of Women Study Cell :**

The women study cell of Goreswar College use to organize a numbers of programme at a regular interval in different themes and subject matters. The programmes held under the guidance of women study cell use to try to keep in touch with women study concerning matters.

**A Survey Report :**

A survey team consisting of 8 teachers and 34 students had visited a village named Barphukankhat for a field survey organised by womens study cell of Goreswar College on 09.12.05. The survey team covers 100 families of that particular

area. The survey mainly targeted the women section of village. The subject of the survey was "Socio-Economic consciousness of women."

**Aim of Survey :**

The main objective of the survey was to study the socio-economic, political educational and cultural consciousness of women in present time.

The survey gave us a positive result that the women's consciousness in different socio-economic matters is very encouraging because the consciousness in the women section is increasing in an inspiring way.

The survey team had earned very good experience during the programme. Most of the villagers show their eagerness to know about the process and they were very co-operative too.

**viii) Progress Report of Alumni Association Cell :**

The Alumni Association Cell of Goreswar College, perform its functions in collaboration with the Alumni Associations of Goreswar College. The various functions performed by the Alumni Cell are purely a reflection of the ideologies of Alumni Association of the College.

The various functions done by the Alumni Association Cell are as follows :

The Association had donated pure drinking water to the students and the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. The Alumni Association had also executed a plan of tree plantations in the boundary sites of the college. The Association is also collecting funds from the various sources which are being donated to the college.

**ix) Progress Report of Publication Cell :**

Goreswar College has a publication cell and the main duty of the cell is to publish a Research oriented half yearly journal named "IMPRESSIONS". Through this journal the Faculty members uses to concentrate their research activities by writing articles, Report etc. So far the cell has brought out Four volume successfully to the readers and gained momentum in bringing out more volumes in recent times. Besides publication of IMPRESSIONS the cell is also engaged in other Literary task of various Departments.

**x) Progress Report of Seminar Cell :**

The seminar cell of Goreswar College is endowed with the responsibility of organising interdisciplinary seminars and talks on various topics in collaboration with the departments concerned. The students, teachers and on some occasions teachers from the nearby institutions also participate in these seminars. The seminar cell although is envisaging to held National level seminars and the UGC Office have been offered proposal for the purpose with plans and estimates, the cell is yet to receive the required grant and approved in this regard. As such no National level seminar could be organised by the cell till date. The details of the seminars held under the various departments in collaboration with seminar cell can be summarised as follows -

**Seminar in the Department of Assamese :**

On the 4th October, 2005 a one day departmental seminar was organised by Assamese Deptt. in co-operation with the seminar cell of Goreswar College. The title

of the seminar was "Sankari Nritya and its future." Dilip Bora a senior grade lecturer of Saraighat College was invited as the resource person.

The topic of the seminar is very important from the point of view of continuity of existence of Assamese culture and tradition. In the seminar it was discussed in a very deliberative way, that how it would be possible to develop the interest of the young generation of Assamese society in Sankari Nritya and it was also tried to highlight on the ways through which Sankari Nritya can be established in the greatest platform of world culture.

#### **Seminar in the Department of Bodo :**

The Deptt. of Bodo of Goreswar College organised a seminar on 16th November'05, in collaboration with the seminar cell. The title of the seminar was "The influence of other language on Bodo poetry."

Mr. Bijoy Baglary, General Secretary of Bodo writers Academy & Mr. Rama Kanta Basumatary, a noted poet were present in the seminar as the resource persons.

Another noted poet Mr. Arabinda Uzir had attended the seminar as the chairperson. The seminar was being inaugurated by the Principal i/c of Goreswar College, Mr. Umesh Deka. Mr Umesh Baro, the HOD of Boro deptt. had given the key note Lecture. The respected resource persons gave a very fruitful lecture on the topic, how the Bodo poems are influenced by the other languages. On what is the extent of influence of different other languages on the Bodo poems.

### **Seminar in the Department of Economics :**

The Deptt. of Economics of Goreswar College organised a seminar in collaboration with the seminar cell on the topic of 'Floriculture : A Dimension of self-employment for Rural Unemployed Youth" on 11/09/05.

Dr. K.K. Barman, Prof. of Economics, Gauhati University was invited as the Resource Person.

The subject matter of the seminar has its own significance, because unemployment has become a burning question in the present day situation. From that point of view, a constructive discussion was held how to help the youths in developing the self-employment process through floriculture.

### **Seminar in the Department of Education :**

The Deptt. of Education of Goreswar College had also organised a seminar in association with the seminar cell of the same college on 06.08.05. The title of the seminar was "Role of Higher Education on the Developments of Youths". Dr. Biren Deka of M.N.C. College was invited as the resource person.

A very resourceful lecture was delivered on the particular theme. Alongwith that it was also been tried to highlight the challenges and the opportunities of higher education and the scope of employment through different vocational courses. Almost 8 (eight) papers were presented by the students.

### **Seminar in the Department of English :**

A departmental seminar was held in the Deptt. of English in collaboration with the seminar cell of Goreswar College on 04/09/05. The topic of the seminar was "Problem of English Teaching in Higher Secondary Level."

Principal I/c Mr. Umesh Deka was presided over the meeting. Dr. Partha Sarathi Mishra of cotton College was invited as the Resource Person of the seminar. Almost all the students of English Department and the teachers of the College participated in the seminar. Madhabi Kalita, Selection Grade Lecturer of Goreswar College and Sarat Deka, Sr. Grade Lecturer of English, Deptt. presented the papers on the topic. The invited resource person gave a fruitful lecture on the topic.

### **Seminar in the Department of History :**

In collaboration with the seminar cell the Deptt. of History organized a departmental seminar on 29.09.05. The topic of the seminar was "Importance of Regional History in the Society Formation - An analytical approach."

Dr. Gajendra Adhikari, a Ph.D. Guide of Gauhati University was invited as the Resource Person in the seminar. The principal of Goreswar College presided over the seminar. Mr. K.P. Borah, C.P. Tamuli and N. Kalita of Deptt. of History presented their paper on the topic and highlighted certain core issues involves in society formation.

Dr. Adhikari elaborated on the topic and highlighted how the regional history has influenced the society and evolves a new dimension in the study of History. During the seminar a light has through on to what extent regional history greatly influenced the revolutionary and nationalist groups, who fought for the cause of their economic development.

### **Seminar in the Department of Political Science :**

The Deptt. of Political Science of Goreswar College organized a departmental seminar on the topic of "Empowerment of Women" on 20.11.05. The seminar cell of Goreswar College has cooperated with the concern Department in the

matter of organizing the seminar. The seminar topic has its great relevance because in the present time a good importance has started to give towards the empowerment of women. Now-a-days it is seen that the upcoming generation of the women section is very much interested to involve themselves in the decision making process of the Family as well as society.

The seminar was graced by Dr. Biraj Das, Head of the Department of Political Science, S.B.M.S. College, Sualkuchi.

### **Seminar in the Department of Philosophy :**

The Deptt. of Philosophy had the privilege of organizing a departmental seminar in the topic of "Interpretation of Gita by Bal Gangadhar Tilak" in collaboration with the seminar cell of Goreswar College on 11/08/05.

Mrs. Kalpana Goswami was the appointed speaker in the seminar. She is a lecturer of Pub Kamrup College, Deptt. of Philosophy. In the seminar it was tried to discuss that how an earthen lamp was lighted by Balgangadhar Tilak for the unity and integrity of the people.

The invited resource person spoke on the occasion how Balgangadhar Tilak reinterpreted the famous Epic of 'Gita' during the period of his enlightenment. Mrs. Goswami also tried to introduce the people with karma yogi Tilak and his karma yoga path.

The seminar was very fruitful for the students of Philosophy.



## **PROGRESS REPORT OF SUPPORT SERVICES OF VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS :**

### **Asomiya Sahitya chora, Department of Assamese :**

Asomiya Sahitya Chora is an independent part of Assamese Department of Goreswar College, through Sahitya Chora, the Department of Assamese carry out side class room services along with the students and the teachers of all the departments.

Every year some literal activities and literal competition are being held through Asomiya Sahitya Chora for all round development of the students. On 22nd December.2005. A Debat competition was held in the college campus through the Asomiya Sahitya Chora. The topic of the Debate competition was "Govt Educational Institutions various private Educational Institutions". Prof. Ajit Talukdar, Senior Lecturer of Assamese Department, was the chair person that debate competition ; Prizes were distributed among the winners in the end of the competition.

### **Education Forum, Department of Education :**

Education Forum is the support service of the Department of Education. Through this Forum, the concern Deptt tries to carry out certain other beneficial activities with the students of Education. The President and the Secretary of the Education Forum takes the initiative to organize various programmes under education Forum.

On 02/10/05 the Education Forum of Education Deptt organize a seminar on value Education and stress Management, The Seminar was presided over by the principal of Goreswar College. Dr. Hem Deka, Head of the Department of Education of Pub Kamrup College was invited as the Resource Person.

Two Papers were presented by the lectures of education department. They are Alka Das and Prativa Patowari. The invited resource Person gave a very fruitful lecture on the topic that is value education and the student were highly benefited by discussion.

### **Historical Study Centre, Department of History :**

Historical study centre acts as the support services for the Deptt. of History. Through this centre the Department carry out some outside classroom activities with the students of History to give them a first hand experience on the ground realities of History. Under the guidance of the secretary of the study centre Mr. Nayan Kalita the centre was undertaken mainly Socio-economic & cultural survey etc.

Keeping this view in mind, the centre carried out an educational excursion on 14.12.05 to Tezpur. In Tezpur the team carried out a rapid journey on the historical sights like - Bamunipahar, the world famous gate of Dah-Parbatiya and many ancient temples with a number of rock inscription scattered in the area. After the completion of the programme the team jointly prepared one survey report in which the pros and corn of the journey is being incorporated. Through this kind of programmes students use to gather knowledge and develop interest in the concern subject.

### **Political Forum , Department of Political Science :**

The Political Forum of Goreswar College under the Deptt of Political Science take certain steps under the guidance of political forum as the support service of the concern departments.

On 21/10/05 the Political Forum organize a group discussion among the students of the Goreswar College on the topic of "The Role & Panchayati Raj in decentralising the powers"

The lectures of political Science supervise the group discussion to assess the Knowledge of students in the concern matter, The group discussion was organized with the intention of developing the Communication Skill and the continuity of thought.

### **Peace and Amity club, Department of Philosophy :**

"Peace and Amity Club" of Department of Philosophy had the privilege of organizing various programmes as the support service of the concerned Deptt.

Under the presidentship of G. Kalita the lecture of philosophy of Goreswar College the peace and Amity club arranged a peace rally which was organized with an intention of establishment of universal peace. All the teachers and students including the principal of Goreswar College participated in the universal peace rally was invited as the inaugurator of the rally. The student of Philosophy took the initiative in organizing the rally. The rally was held on 01.09.05.

**3. Innovation in Curricular design and Transaction :**

Goreswar College follows the prescribed syllabus of Gauhati University. Although the college has no authority to change or design the syllabus the Departments of the College have propagated some outside class room activities in many Departments. The innovative ideas include organisation of symposium on few relevant topics of the subjects and their utility to the society social responsibility and the obligation of the

teachers and student to the society is being reflected through these innovation programme of curriculam.

#### **4. Inter-disciplinary Programmes started :**

All the departments of Goreswar College is actively associated with their own subject and syllabus. The Faculty members and the Teaching Departments have propagated some interdisciplinary programmes for the benefit of the student and for the upgradation and Quality enhancement. During this programmes the Departments recognises some core and similar issues which match the topics of the Departments. For instance, the Education Departments and the History Departments exchanges their Faculty members to give variety to the student and teachers. Economics and Mathematics Departments also exchanges their faculty members to teach similar topic. In such a way the college authority has offered the variety through interdisciplinary programmes.

#### **5. Examination reforms implemented :**

The college has no authority over the examination system of Gauhati University. The final examination is controlled by the University authority. But in the internal examination system of the college has certain jurisdiction. Accordingly the college has the provision of two unit test and one Pre-final examination. Apart from these the Department held oral examination for 25 marks to evaluate the achievement of major subject in the stream.

### **22. Course in which student assessment of teacher's is introduced and the action taken on student feedbacks :**

At the end of the academic season the college prepared an assessment of Teachers known as student feedback. In TDC II<sup>nd</sup> yr and in TDC III<sup>rd</sup> year the feedback is taken regularly. The Teachers are assessed under the 10 point scale rating. After scrutinising the various attitudes of Teachers as rated by the student the average rating is taken into account. The teachers are given intimation regarding his/ her rating and necessary advice & guidance are also given to improve his/ her level of knowledge and his/ her strength and weaknesses. The principal and the IQAC of the college has an annual sitting with the teacher's to evaluate the serious matters arises out of the feedback report.

## 24. Computerisation of administration and the process of admissions and examination results, issue of certificates :

### i) **Computerisation of administration :**

The administration of Goreswar college is not wholly computerised. The process is going on. Filing of the account, proceedings of the meeting of students teacher's interaction, staff meeting etc. are being under processed. With the help of documentation the college is trying to conduct the administration smoothly.

### ii) **Process of Admissions :**

For the process of admission forms are distributed among the students with a distinct cut of marks. The cut of marks vary from time to time. The college has an admission committee which scrutinised the forms. After that a selection list is handed up strictly in merit basis. After that with requisite fees the process of admission is completed

### iv) **Issue of certificates :**

After passing the final examination the office issues the pass certificates after the students fulfilled the required conditions. Issue of certificate takes place after the office assistant verifies the requisite norms. At last the principal of the college issues pass certificates to the concerned students. The university authority issues pass certificates on the basis of the Principal's recommendation.

**25. Increase in the infrastructural facility :**

In the session 2005-06 the college authority has adopted various projects in the infrastructure development. The college Auditorium construction is going on in full swing. The auditorium is partly funded by UGC. At the same time the college Girls Hostel's Construction is also in process which is also a UGC funded project. A few class room is also constructed and renovated during the session which has boosted up the infrastructure capacity of the college.

The most noteworthy development of infrastructure of the college is the establishment of multi Gymnastics Hall. The Gym is funded by the Ministry of Sports & Youth Welfare, Govt of India. A regular physical training to the students is provided through the Gymnasium Hall.

**26. Technology upgradation :**

In the field of Technology upgradation the College is not able to do a remarkable development Because in the communication technology the area is not so much developed. Being situated in the foot hill of Bhutan, the remote area is deprived of latest communication technology such as Internet communication. Within a limited scope the teaching Departments are taking the help of Audio- visual aid for better quality upgradation. In such a way, the teaching learning process is completed with the available technology.

**27. Computer and Internet access and training to Teacher & the student :**

The college has an active computer education cell and it is responsible in providing computer education of the faculty members and students. At Present a

certificate in computer application is running on for the students. As well as the students the faculty members are also itake part in the training course and acquainted with the computer education. But in the field of Internet connectivity there is no provision for internet access as the locality is remain out side the purview of internet Networks.

### **28. Financial aid of students :**

According to the plan of IQAC, Goreswar college is providing financial aid to the poor and meritorious student. It offers free admission to 5 students in the session 2005-06. Apart from this they are also provided with free text Book and other study materials Every years the college provides these kind of financial aid to the poor and meritorious students of the college.

### **29. Activities and support from the Allumni Association :**

The Allumni association have certain mentionable functions in Goreswar College. The Association has donated two acquagaurd sets which help in providing pure drinking water to the students and the teaching staff and non-teaching staff of the college.

The Allumni Association has also executed a plan of tree plantation in the boundary of the college. They are also collecting funds from the various sources which are been donated to the College authority very frequently.

### **30. Activities and support from the parent-Teacher Association :**

The college has an active parent Teacher Association. To have a better academic environment and transparency in educational system. IQAC offers that the parent-Teacher Association must sit twice a year. First on January and second in the

month of August of the year. Accordingly in the session 2005-06, the meeting was held and parents of the locality responded positively and put-forwarded their view and suggestions regarding the Academic atmosphere and the quality upgradation . The Association also offer their support to the steps taken by the IQAC in the field of higher education. Apart from this half yearly process the parents are encouraged to visit the institution in a regular basis and free to offer constructive criticism regarding the ongoing educational scenario in the institution. The half yearly sitting of the Association is held on 9th January and 29th August of the session.
